The journal *Arqueologia* is a peer-reviewed, open access journal which focuses primarily on archaeological research conducted in the Americas or by researchers based at universities in the Americas. The journal does not focus on any specific time period.

Arqueologia publishes several main types of articles, including research articles, short reports, and summary-synthesis articles, and special category articles such as editorials, interviews, and reviews of books and events. The journal also publishes special issues comprised of monographs or instructional manuals. At the moment, we are accepting articles in Portuguese, Spanish, English, and French.
